# THE BRUCE ROBINSON RALLY

## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT.

The Lincoln Motor Cycle and Car Club Ltd. will promote a National B Permit Road Rally and a National B Permit Historic Road Rally on the 10/11th February 2007

### 2. JURISDICTION.

- a) The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the M.S.A. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA ).
- b) These Supplementary Regulations.
- c) Final Instructions, having the same force as these regulations.
- d) Any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

### 3. AUTHORISATION.

MSA Permit Nos.            DOE Authorisation No.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY.

The event is open to:-

- i) All fully elected members of the organising club.
- ii) Members of the following Associations, including their Road Rally and Historic Rally Championship Contenders:-  
Association of North East Midland Motor Clubs  
East Midlands Association of Motor Clubs (HRCR is a Member Club)  
Association of Northern Car Clubs.

The event is a round of the EMAMC and ANEMMC Road Rally and Historic Championships, a round of the ANCC Road Rally .

All drivers and navigators must produce a valid Club Membership Card and a Competition Licence valid for the event, which will be inspected at signing on.

### 5. START AND FINISH.

The event will start from LA Leisure Ltd, Kingsley Road Development, Lincoln.(121/ 926681). and breakfast and results will be available at The George Hotel, Langworth (121/ 064766). Scrutineering will commence at 20.30hrs and competitors must be scrutineered and signed on 1 hour before their due start time. Individual times for scrutineering will be notified in the Final Instructions which will have the same power as these SR's and be posted to Navigators on the Tues prior to the event. The first car will start at 00:01hrs. All cars will start at one minute intervals.

### 6. ROUTE.

The route will be approximately 140 miles. Any private roads used on the event have prior consent of the Landowners. Competitors will be issued with their Time Cards at the Start. Route instructions will be given out at intervals during the rally, and these will provide all the information necessary to comply with K.19. There may be a number of Regularity Sections and you will be required to stop at any intermediate controls for the purpose of recording a time. K. 15.4. Secret checks may be established to ensure compliance with route instructions, speed schedule technical regulations and noise. K. 16.7.1, K.16.7.2. The Maps required are the latest editions of O.S. 1:50,000 series numbers 121 (C1), 122 (C1). Competitors are reminded of K. 14.3. with regard to marked maps.

### 7. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS.

#### Road Rally.

All vehicles must comply with the current MSA Technical Regulations - including those in respect of Standard Cars.

#### Historic Road Rally.

Cars must comply fully with the MSA's Technical Regulations for Historic and Post Historic Rally cars.



## 12. ENTRIES.

Entries open on the publication of these SR's and close at midnight on 6th February 2007. The entry fee is £50 which will include the cost of two hearty breakfasts. All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the entry fee. The maximum entry is 50 and the minimum is 30. Should the minimum entry not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the event. In the event of an entry being withdrawn in writing before the closing date, entry fees will be refunded less an administration fee of £5.00. late entries may be accepted at the Organisers discretion.

## 13. RESULTS.

Provisional results will be published in accordance with B.13.1b where practicable otherwise B.13.1d will apply. All protests are to be made in accordance with O.5, O.6, E.7.1.6.

## 16. INSURANCE.

### ALEXANDER FORBES RALLY SCHEME

The Club have applied to Alexander Forbes Insurance Brokers for a Blanket Certificate of Insurance under the above scheme to provide to those Competitors who need to use the Scheme with Third Party Cover to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the event. The Standard Premium for the Event (before any loadings) will be £26 inc VAT.

**In order to compete on the event, drivers must be able to sign one of the following declarations and/or provide proof of insurance cover in accordance with B 9.4.2(b).at signing on:-**

- 1 I have extended my own motor insurance in accordance with B 9.4.2(b).
- 2 I have a Alexander Forbes letter confirming terms on which they will cover me.
- 4 I hold a valid Bowring NES letter and require cover under the Alexander Forbes Scheme. The premiums have not been loaded in the past.
- 5 I have neither an Alexander Forbes nor a valid Bowring NES letter, but require cover under the Alexander Forbes Scheme. I declare that I have:
  - (5.1) No physical or mental disabilities.
  - (5.2) No convictions other than a maximum of six speeding points.
  - (5.3) No more than one fault accident in the last three years.
  - (5.4) and that I am over 18 years old and have held a full licence for at least six months
  - (5.5) No other material facts to disclose.

If you are unable to sign any of these declarations please indicate on the entry form and we will send you details of how we can help arrange cover for you.

## 17. MISCELLANEOUS.

- i) The organisers times and mileage shall be deemed correct and are **not** subject to protest.
- ii) Force majeure notwithstanding, the organisers reserve the right to delete penalties at any control or check and /or delete any part of the route from the results if they deem it fair to do so.
- iii) Any notice displayed at the start or during the route bearing an official's signature will have the same force as these SR's.
- iv) Competitors are reminded of the requirements for Neutral Sections as per K.15.3.6. No auxiliary lighting may be used except as permitted by law in conditions of fog or falling snow.
- v) Petrol will be available near the start and after approximately 80 miles.
- vi) Mobile phones may be carried in the competing car for use in an accident or emergency. Failure to conform will be penalised as per K.18.p.

## 18. NAVIGATION.

The correct route will be the shortest route which complies with the route instructions unless instructed otherwise. **CRO** = coloured roads only, **AR** = all roads. We may be using some or all of the following types of navigation:-

*you will be told whether they are in or out of order.*

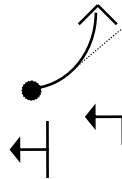
### SPOT HEIGHTS

### TULIPS

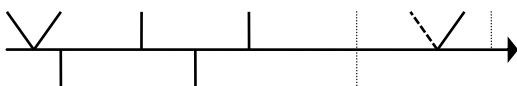
Schematic drawing of junctions as map

or in a string 8990189118

*you will be told whether they are out of order.*

### MAP FEATURES

The feature will actually touch the road such as gradient arrow, mile post or electricity line.
